

Modern Slavery Act 2015 - Advanced Access Platforms Policy Statement

The directors of Advanced Access Platforms Ltd has examined the risk of modern slavery within its business operations and considers the risks to be low. This assessment is based upon the nature of the business, which is a service operating solely in England.

As a service provider, Advanced Access Platforms Ltd's largest resource is the employees and any, occasional, agency workers. Advanced Access Platforms Ltd rigorously checks that all its employees have the right to work in this country and pays at or above the appropriate National Minimum Wage and/or Living Wage rates. The same rigor is applied to ensuring that any agency workers are similarly checked by their respective employer and that no bonded labour is supplied.

Other supply chains of the business provide items for Advanced Access Platforms Ltd's own use

- MEWPS (for the use of hire)
- Vehicles
- Uniforms
- Office equipment & stationery
- Legal, accounting, and professional advisers
- Parts and components
- Cleaning materials

All the above is sourced from within the UK.

All suppliers are required to ensure that they comply with the statutory requirements in respect of the Modern Slavery Act 2015, which, in turn, confirms to us that the risk of slavery in our supply chain has been mitigated.

Advanced Access Platforms Ltd will review this policy on an annual basis.
